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Screeners – The Clinic will pre-screen patients Monday mornings as well as the last Tuesday evening of the month. Individuals are needed to meet with patients face to face to take patient information and determine if they are eligible to be seen at the Clinic.
Hall Floater – The floater will assist the Director, physicians and nurses with patient flow during patient visits on clinic nights, Tuesdays and Thursdays. This will include monitoring exam rooms, patient charts, and escorting patient from point to point.
Food Donors – The clinic would like to provide food for the volunteers who work clinic nights. We are looking for individuals, groups, organizations, churches, etc. To provide food for 20 volunteers on Tuesday and Thursday evenings.
Clerical – The clinic needs volunteers to do filing, data entry, operate office equipment, answer telephone, and conduct pre-screening interviews with potential patients over the phone.
Maintenance – The clinic needs volunteers to help with routine maintenance of the building.
Housekeeping – This includes assisting with the cleaning of the clinic. Wednesday and Friday mornings after clinic night is a preferred time, as well as other times for general cleaning.
Interpreters – We anticipate patients from all walks of life and different cultural backgrounds. We will need interpreters for these different groups.
Patient Assistance – Pharmaceutical companies offer free medications to patients of the clinic through their patient assistance programs. Volunteers are needed to submit medication ordering applications for each patient.
Patient Education – We will be offering and requiring in some cases, patients of the clinic to attend education classes. This may include nutrition, chronic illness care such as high blood pressure, diabetes, etc. We need someone familiar in these particular areas willing to conduct these classes.
Communications - The clinic will produce a quarterly newsletter and is looking for individuals who enjoy writing or would be interested in submitting articles and helping put together the news letter. Also needed are volunteers to post photos and commentary to Face Book.
Special Projects – Volunteers needed to help with special projects such as fundraisers, events, mailings, writing thank you notes, addressing envelopes, etc.
